Re-Registration for Returning Students

- Full amount paid between March 24-April 7, 2025: \$885 per student or \$1,235 per Gr. 5 student
- Full amount paid between April 8-22, 2025: \$985 per student or \$1,335 per Gr. 5 student
- Full amount paid between April 23-May 6, 2025: \$1,085 per student or \$1,435 per Gr. 5 student
- Full amount paid on/after May 7, 2025: \$1,185 per student or \$1,535 per Gr. 5 student

Terms and Conditions (see full details in the School Handbook)

1. Tuition payment for the first month and the registration fee are due at the time of registration and are non-refundable for both new and returning students. **If payment is not received by the due date, your registration may be canceled.**
2. Tuition Payment Installment Plan: First payment by August 1, 2025; remaining nine (9) installments by the 10th of each month beginning September of 2025.
3. Payment of registration fee signifies agreement to following all school rules and regulations as outlined in the Family Handbook, including the tuition payment schedule.
4. School fees are NON-REFUNDABLE for all new and/or returning students.
5. Only students who are re-registered for the upcoming school year without outstanding balances can be admitted to Summer School.
6. Tuitions and fees are paid using the online FACTS system.
7. For financial assistance, an application must be completed on FACTS Grants & Aid .
8. Full payment paid on FACTS by August 1, 2025 earns 1% discount of the annual tuition.
9. A late fee of \$75 per month applies to all late payments.
10. International students should contact the Admissions Office for their tuition schedule.

Registration Fee	\$200	The annual fee covers the cost of online registration, payment collection tools (FACTS), and administrative processing.
Instructional Fee	\$385	<p>This annual fee covers the cost of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Software licenses for the student (IXL, i-Ready, NewsELA), RtI support, Summative District tests and prep materials; hardware (iPads, cases, etc.); Apps, Blackboard, Go Guardian, and School Messenger. Student materials including: folders, binders, notebooks, and homework agenda planner.
Commitment Fee	\$300	This fee is a show of good faith and commitment to the school.

Kindergarten Graduation Fee	\$60	This one-time cost (due May 1, 2026) covers the personalized mementos and keepsake gifts and celebratory yard sign.
8th Grade Graduation Fee	\$200	This one-time cost (due May 1, 2026) covers the cost of the graduation luncheon, cap and gown, diploma and cover, partial cost of the graduation class trip, and other expenses related to graduation.
New Student Fee	\$200	This is a one-time fee for new students.
Chromebook Usage Fee	\$350	This is a one-time fee for all 5 th graders and new junior high students, due upon enrollment. It includes the cost of the Chromebook, Chrome OS management license, and general maintenance support.
