### Re-Registration for Returning Students

- Full amount paid by March 18: \$885 per student or \$1,235 per Gr. 5 student
- Full amount paid between March 19-April 16, 2026: \$985 per student or \$1,335 per Gr. 5 student
- Full amount paid between April 17-May 1, 2026: \$1,085 per student or \$1,435 per Gr. 5 student
- Full amount paid on/after May 2, 2026: \$1,185 per student or \$1,535 per Gr. 5 student

### Terms and Conditions (see full details in the School Handbook)

1. Tuition payment for the first month and the registration fee are due at the time of registration and are non-refundable for both new and returning students. **If payment is not received by the due date, your registration may be canceled.**
2. Tuition Payment Installment Plan: First payment by August 1, 2026; remaining nine (9) installments by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month beginning September of 2026.
3. Payment of registration fee signifies agreement to following all school rules and regulations as outlined in the Family Handbook, including the tuition payment schedule.
4. School fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE** for all new and/or returning students. If you notify the school after **March 18** that you intend to re-register your student, a FACTS invoice will be issued with an automatic withdrawal date set for **10 days after the date of notification**. For example, if you notify us on **April 10**, the FACTS auto-withdrawal will be scheduled for **April 20**. Please note that if payment is not scheduled by **April 16**, the re-registration fee will increase to the rate applicable for the **April 17–May 1, 2026** window.
5. Only students who re-registered for the upcoming school year without outstanding balances can be admitted to Summer School.
6. Tuitions and fees are paid using the online FACTS system.
7. For financial assistance, an application must be completed on FACTS Grants & Aid .
8. Full payment paid on FACTS by August 1, 2026 earns 1% discount of the annual tuition.
9. A late fee of \$75 per month applies to all late payments.
10. International students should contact the Admissions Office for their tuition schedule.

<b>Tuition</b>	Varies by grade	<p>Tuition includes the following but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Professional salaries and benefits</li> <li>School curriculum and programming</li> <li>Health and property insurance</li> <li>Building utilities, maintenance, and repairs</li> <li>School health and safety programs</li> <li>Other school expenses</li> </ul> <p>Tuition does not include the costs for the After School Program and activities, athletics, field trips, yearbook, and school pictures.</p>
<b>Standard Fees</b>		
<b>Registration Fee</b>	\$200	The annual fee covers the cost of online registration, payment collection tools (FACTS), and administrative processing.
<b>Instructional Fee</b>	\$385	<p>This annual fee covers the cost of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Software licenses for the student (IXL, i-Ready, NewsELA), RtI support, Summative District tests and prep materials; hardware (iPads, cases, etc.); Apps, Blackboard, Go Guardian, and School Messenger.</li> <li>Student materials including: folders, binders, notebooks, and homework agenda planner.</li> </ul>
<b>Commitment Fee</b>	\$300	This fee is a show of good faith and commitment to the school.
<b>Other Fees</b>		
<b>Kindergarten Graduation Fee</b>	\$60	This one-time cost (due May 1, 2027) covers the personalized mementos and keepsake gifts and celebratory yard sign.
<b>8<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation Fee</b>	\$200	This one-time cost (due May 1, 2027) covers the cost of the graduation luncheon, cap and gown, diploma and cover, partial cost of the graduation class trip, and other expenses related to graduation.
<b>New Student Fee</b>	\$200- \$1,000	This is a one-time fee for new students. The fee is \$200 for new students applying to grades PK-K, \$500 for new students applying to grades 1-2, \$750 for students applying to grades 3-5, and \$1,000 for new students applying to grades 6-8.
<b>Chromebook Usage Fee</b>	\$350	This is a one-time fee for all 5 <sup>th</sup> graders and new junior high students, due upon enrollment. It includes the cost of the Chromebook, Chrome OS management license, and general maintenance support.
<b>Fundraising</b>	\$350- \$500	<p>This is a mandatory annual amount which varies based upon how many students are enrolled.</p> <p><b>For families with one student:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>50/50 Grand Raffle - \$200 (due mid-November 2026)</li> <li>Chinese New Year Raffle - \$100 (due mid-January 2027)</li> <li>Spring Raffle - \$50 (due mid-March 2027)</li> </ul> <p><b>For families with two or more students:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>50/50 Grand Raffle - \$300 (due mid-November 2026)</li> <li>Chinese New Year Raffle - \$100 (due mid-January 2027)</li> <li>Spring Raffle - \$100 (due mid-March 2027)</li> </ul>
